Provision is made for students with Special Educational Needs and English as an Additional Language (SEND/EAL). Individual pupil profiles and target sheets are utilized to identify the specific requirements of these students, ensuring that teaching methods and support are tailored accordingly to facilitate progress. In instances where students with a statement of Special Educational Needs (SEND) or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) join Phoenix Learning Centre LTD, our management conducts thorough assessments to understand their needs. Subsequently, personalized pupil profiles and risk assessments, if necessary, are prepared to guide staff in delivering tailored teaching methods conducive to the student's progress.

Our curriculum is flexible and adapted to meet the needs of all students, including those with SEND or EHCPs. Regular reviews involving parents/carers are conducted (where appropriate) for students with an EHCP to ensure their educational needs are met effectively.

Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) and Citizenship education are integrated throughout all Key Stages, while Information Technology (IT) is seamlessly incorporated across various subjects. Students are equipped with skills to retrieve and utilize information in both electronic and traditional formats, in accordance with age-appropriate guidelines and our Online Safety and Online Teaching Policy.

While Phoenix Learning Centre LTD adheres to the overarching principles of the National Curriculum, we maintain flexibility to tailor our educational approach to suit the unique needs and strengths of our students, deviating from strict adherence to detailed specifications when necessary.

The broad policies of each Key Stage of the school are outlined below:

EYFS

At Phoenix Learning Centre LTD, our Early Years practitioners understand the crucial significance of early childhood in children's development, acknowledging that this period is marked by rapid physical, intellectual, emotional, and social growth. Recognizing that children learn and progress at varying rates and through diverse means, our practitioners are dedicated to delivering high-quality early years education to ensure optimal outcomes for all children.

Through careful observation and documentation of children's skills and interests, our practitioners tailor experiences that cater to individual needs and align with each child's developmental stage. KS1

At Phoenix Learning Centre LTD, core and foundation subjects are taught distinctly, ensuring that children have access to a comprehensive curriculum. Our sessions are organized to offer a blend of whole-class, group, and individual activities, fostering a balanced learning environment.

Students at Phoenix Learning Centre LTD are taught in mixed-ability classes, where differentiated tasks cater to their individual needs and abilities. This approach ensures that each child receives tailored instruction to support their learning journey effectively.

KS2

At Phoenix Learning Centre LTD, Key Stage 2 (KS2) provides various opportunities to accommodate the diverse learning styles of children. Teaching methods are tailored to suit whole classes, smaller groups, or individual students, ensuring a personalized approach to learning. Classes in KS2 are mixed-ability, allowing for differentiated tasks that cater to the specific needs of each child. In instances where there are multiple classes within a year group, maths and English may be taught in ability sets to further support targeted learning.

The core and foundation subjects in KS2 are taught separately, providing a comprehensive educational experience across various disciplines.

Additionally, specialized 11+ preparation lessons are offered to Year 4 and Year 5 students, equipping them with the skills and knowledge necessary for entrance exams and academic advancement.

KS3/KS4/KS5

At Phoenix Learning Centre LTD, we adhere to the National Curriculum guidelines while delivering tailored lessons for Key Stages 3 (KS3), 4 (KS4), and 5 (KS5). Our curriculum is structured to accommodate the options chosen for GCSE and A-Level exams, ensuring that students receive appropriate instruction and support in their chosen subjects.
